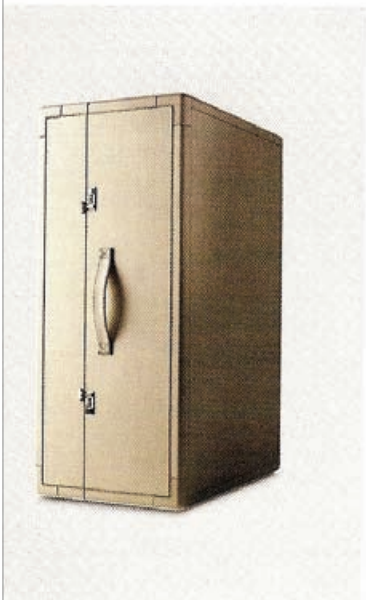


For the design of the malt shop-inspired **Ronnybrook Milk Bar**, ex-Studio Red designer Mark Sarosi, in partnership with Brooklyn architects Studio A+i, kept the kitsch to a minimum. Instead of pastels and sock-hop imagery, the team did retro with glass milk bottles, a 360-degree bar, and 750 antique milk crates stacked up the walls to give the space a rustic farmhouse feel. Some crates can be pulled out of the wall to form tables and benches for extra seating.
